Not all the definitions are included in the study guide because those not in all translations are omitted from the quiz. The Quiz will focus on the theme, terms, definitions and memorization verses. Quizzers will not be asked to recite a verse, but will be asked about verses that begin, end or contain certain phrases.

The quiz will contain 10 multiple choice questions (A, B, or C) and 10 huddle (short answer) questions. Teams will collaborate on all questions.
